Consider where the grout is going to be used, a darker shade tends to show less dirt.







For a uniform look, select a grout color that is a close match to the tile for a tone on tone effect. This will make the room look bigger.

Choosing a shade that is slightly different than the tile color will give your installation more depth and interest.

To emphasize each tile, choose a grout in a contrasting color. The grout then acts as a frame for each tile giving the installation a grid effect.

It produces dense joints that are highly resistant to shrinking, cracking, powdering and wear. Exceeds ANSI A118.6 requirements.

Polyblend® Non-Sanded Grout – For narrow joints up to 1/8" wide. Excellent for highly glazed ceramic tile and highly polished marble or natural stone that can be scratched by sanded grouts. It's non-shrinking and durable. Exceeds ANSI A118.6 requirements.

Saltillo Grout Mix – For wide joints from 1/2" to 1-1/4" often used when installing saltillo, terra-cotta or other clay pavers. Pre-mixed blend eliminates the need for site mixing.


